GROUNDBREAKING ADVOCATE, INSPIRING ROLE MODEL Elizabeth Holtzman: A Woman for All Seasons



- A graduate of Radcliffe College and Harvard Law School, Ms. Holtzman's distinguished career includes serving four terms in Congress where, at the time, she was the youngest woman ever elected to Congress.
- She served on the House Judiciary Committee during the Nixon impeachment proceedings; chaired the Refugee subcommittee and spearheaded efforts to bring Nazi war criminals to justice.
- She was elected District Attorney in Brooklyn in 1985.
- In 1989. she was the first woman elected to be Comptroller of New York City.
- In 1999 President Clinton appointed her to the agency overseeing the declassification of 8 million pages of secret Nazi war crimes.
- In 2013 U.S. Secretary of Defense Chuck Hagel appointed her to a panel that examined handling of sexual assaults in the military.
- Ms. Holtzman is currently a practicing attorney and author, writing about politics in this age of political turmoil.
